2021 CVSA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

As North America's leading commercial motor vehicle safety organization, the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's (CVSA) College Scholarship Award Program is a key component of the Alliance's educational outreach initiative. CVSA provides two to four college scholarships annually to select graduating high school seniors whose parent or legal guardian is a member of the Alliance in good standing. This scholarship program is competitive in its selection criteria, uniquely tailored to recognize outstanding high school seniors by weighing academic performance, volunteer work and extracurricular activities.

ELIGIBILITY

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The candidate must:

- Be a legal dependent of a Class I Member, Class II Local Member, Class III Associate Member or Class IV Federal Member (cannot be a legal dependent of a member of the CVSA Board of Directors)
- Be a graduating high school senior
- Have a minimum high school grade point average (GPA) or equivalent of 3.0
- Be a citizen and/or permanent legal resident of Canada, Mexico or the U.S.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The following documents must be submitted together and must be received by April 30, 2021, to be considered.

1. Completed application form
2. High school transcript
3. Two essays (format: typed, one page each, double spaced)
 - a) How can CVSA reach out to drivers about the importance of safety and sharing the road with commercial motor vehicles?
 - b) What are your career aspirations and why?
4. Two letters of recommendation – one from a teacher and one from another adult who is a non-relative
5. Acceptance letter from an accredited college or university

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applications must be completed with all of the above listed documentation submitted together at the same time by April 30 in order to be considered. Incomplete applications will be disqualified. Applications may be sent to CVSA via traditional mail or email. See the last page of the application for mailing address and email address for submission.

SELECTION PROCESS

The scholarship program is based on academic achievement and extracurricular activities. Recipients will be selected by the CVSA Scholarship Committee based on application documentation provided. Scholarship recipients will be notified of the committee's decision by May 29, 2020. Payment will be made to the recipient's school of choice upon notification and in accordance with the school's scholarship guidelines.

AWARDS

\$1,000 scholarship(s) will be awarded at the discretion of the CVSA Scholarship Committee.

The CVSA College Scholarship Award Program is dedicated to Gary E. Curtis.

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
