- **Speeding was a factor in 26% of all traffic fatalities in 2018, killing 9,378 people or an average of more than 25 people per day.**

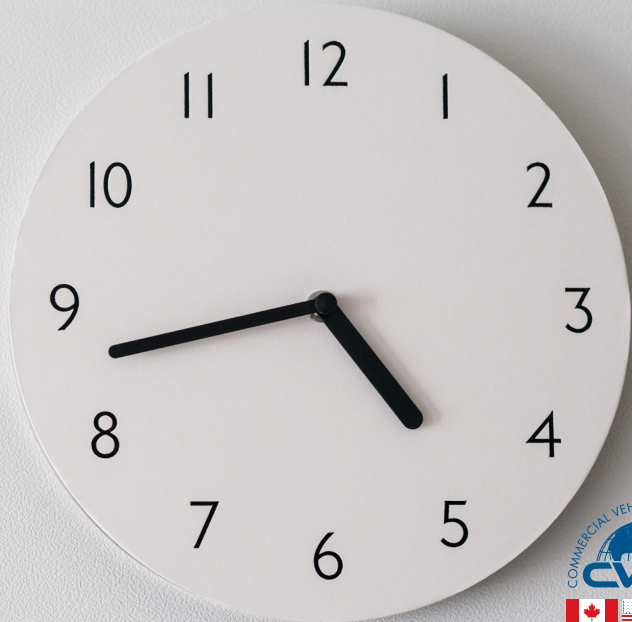

Law enforcement personnel will be on the lookout for commercial motor vehicle drivers and passenger vehicle drivers engaging in dangerous driver behaviors, such as speeding, distracted driving, failure to use a seatbelt, following too closely, aggressive driving, failure to obey traffic control devices, drunk or drugged driving, etc. Drivers engaging in such driving behaviors will be pulled over by law enforcement and may be issued a warning or citation.
